### *Covid-19 Secure*



We are delighted to resume our popular Sunday Lunches, held on the last Sunday of the month and we invite you to join us for traditional Sunday lunch in our splendid surroundings; relax over coffee; and if it appeals, take a stroll around our wonderful 10 acre gardens - to make the whole occasion a special afternoon, not just a meal.

Yew Lodge is a family business and our reputation is based on excellent quality and service. All meals are freshly prepared using local produce whenever possible and we work hard to ensure everything runs smoothly and the afternoon is a great pleasure for everyone.

A two course meal followed by coffee/tea & mints is £26 per adult & £15 per child under 12 years. A full bar is also available. The dress code is smart casual.

To ensure we offer a Covid-19 secure environment we are complying with the Government Guidelines for the hospitality sector which are available on their website: [Gov UK Covid-19 Secure Guidelines](https://www.gov.uk/guidelines/covid-19) . These may need to be updated if the Guidelines change but in summary they are currently:

- Advance reservations only
- We will ask for your name, telephone number and email address when booking (to support the test and trace system)
- Groups inside are limited to members of any two households
- Groups outside can be six from any number of families (but subject to dry weather)

- We will maintain social distancing (two metres between tables/groups or a minimum of one metre with the mitigation of hand sanitiser sachets available on each individual dining table)
- The safety of guests is our prime concern and although it will detract from the overall ambience of our venue our staff will be wearing protective visors.
- On arrival, we ask that you wait at the entrance to be seated and hand sanitizer will be available for your use
- We will use an infrared thermometer to take the temperature of each guest and if it above normal we will need to ask that guest to leave
- You will be shown straight to your table for full table service (no standing at/use of the bar)
- Assigning dedicated staff to each table as far as possible
- Menus left on each dining table through-out meal service
- Condiments left on each dining table and cleaned at the end of meal service
- Cutlery not laid out in advance but brought wrapped in a napkin when serving the main course
- The gardens are open and available for a stroll – we ask that everyone observes social distancing
- Paying the bill will debit/credit card only i.e. cash free
- There will be signage to ask that only one person/group enters the ladies or gents toilets at a time

We are acting in the best interests of everyone during these extraordinary times and if guests fail to observe these safety measures we will be unable to provide our services to them.
